The Project Zero Fellows Program

This program is one of the longest running and most successful of the on-going programs sponsored by the Collaborative. This year it will be expanded and redesigned to better incorporate best learning practices and to accommodate the wide spectrum of familiarity with the work of PZ. Those who have extensive experience with the Teaching for Understanding framework and other research done by the principal investigators at Project Zero will not only continue their growth and inquiry but will also find new opportunities to become leaders in their schools and with their peers in the program. Those participants who are relatively or completely new to the rich and highly respected work of PZ will find a forum for deep thinking and reflection about teaching and learning. In the course of the five meetings, four of which will be for the full day, we will practice new protocols and methods, learn more about topics of interest to the group with visiting researchers from Harvard, and work on individual projects that will be shared, observed, reflected upon, and documented. We will model the practice of life-long learning and the building of professional learning communities.

Please note that previous attendance at one or more the BATDC Project Zero Summer Institutes is not a requirement for participation in this program.
