Rob Evans will provide insights into the School's year-long study of balance in our students' lives. Preceding this workshop for parents, Rob will also lead discussions during a planned Faculty Retreat.

There is no harder job than being a parent. No paid work touches so much of a person so deeply-or so unpredictably-and there is no training for it. As the pace of life accelerates, as media influences intensify, and as the future grows less predictable, parents and schools find it harder to know how to raise children of character, caring, and competence. Rob Evans will outline key dilemmas in childrearing and offer concrete suggestions for successful coping at home and school.

Dr. Robert Evans is a clinical and organizational psychologist and the Executive Director of The Human Relations Service in Wellesley, Massachusetts. A former high school and pre-school teacher who received his undergraduate degree from Princeton and his doctorate from Harvard, he consults to schools throughout North America and internationally, working with teachers, administrators, boards, and parents. He speaks at many state, regional, and national conferences. He is the author of many articles and a book, The Human Side of School Change. Rob is currently at work on a new book, Family Matters: How Schools Can Cope with The Crisis in American Childrearing.
